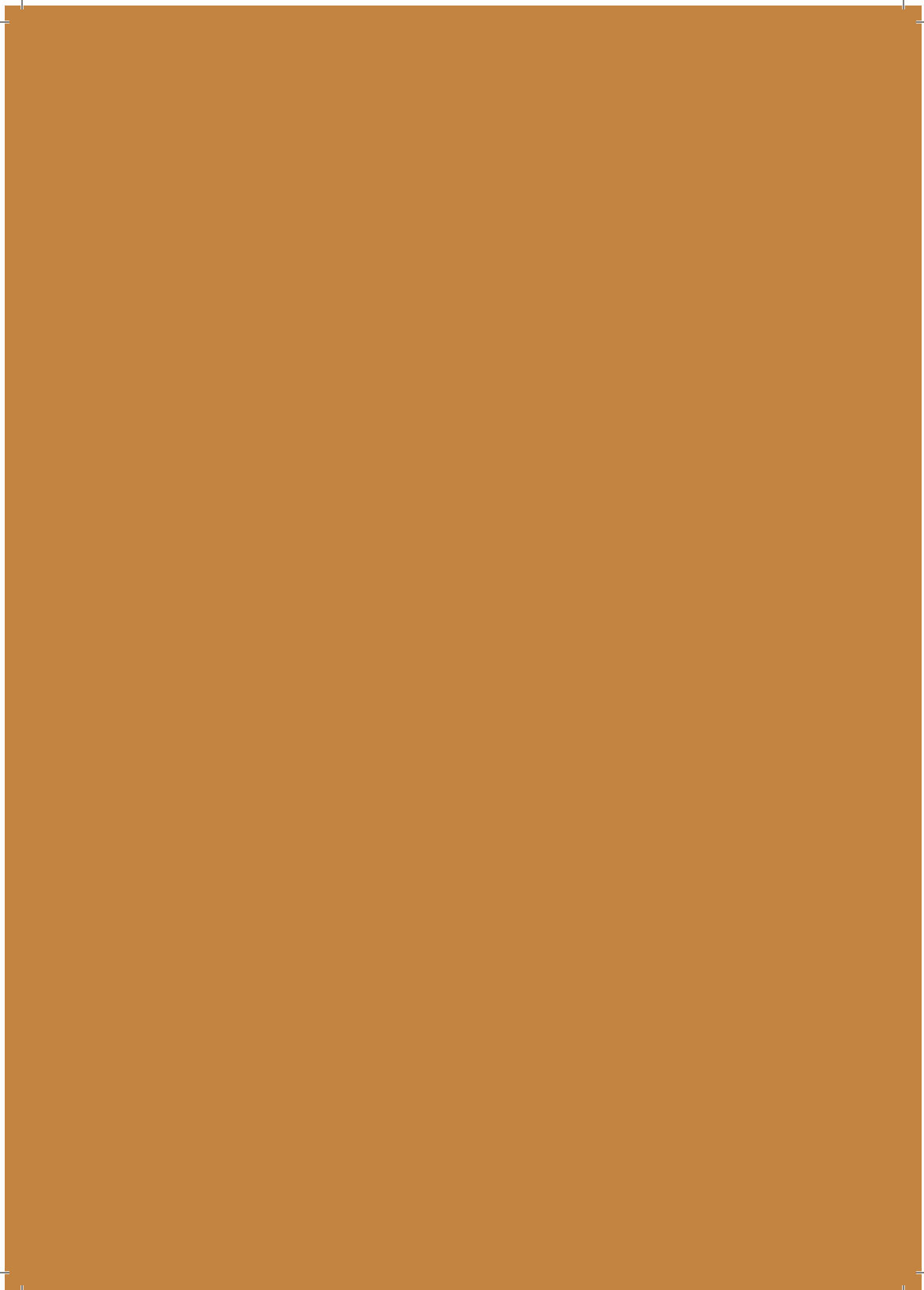

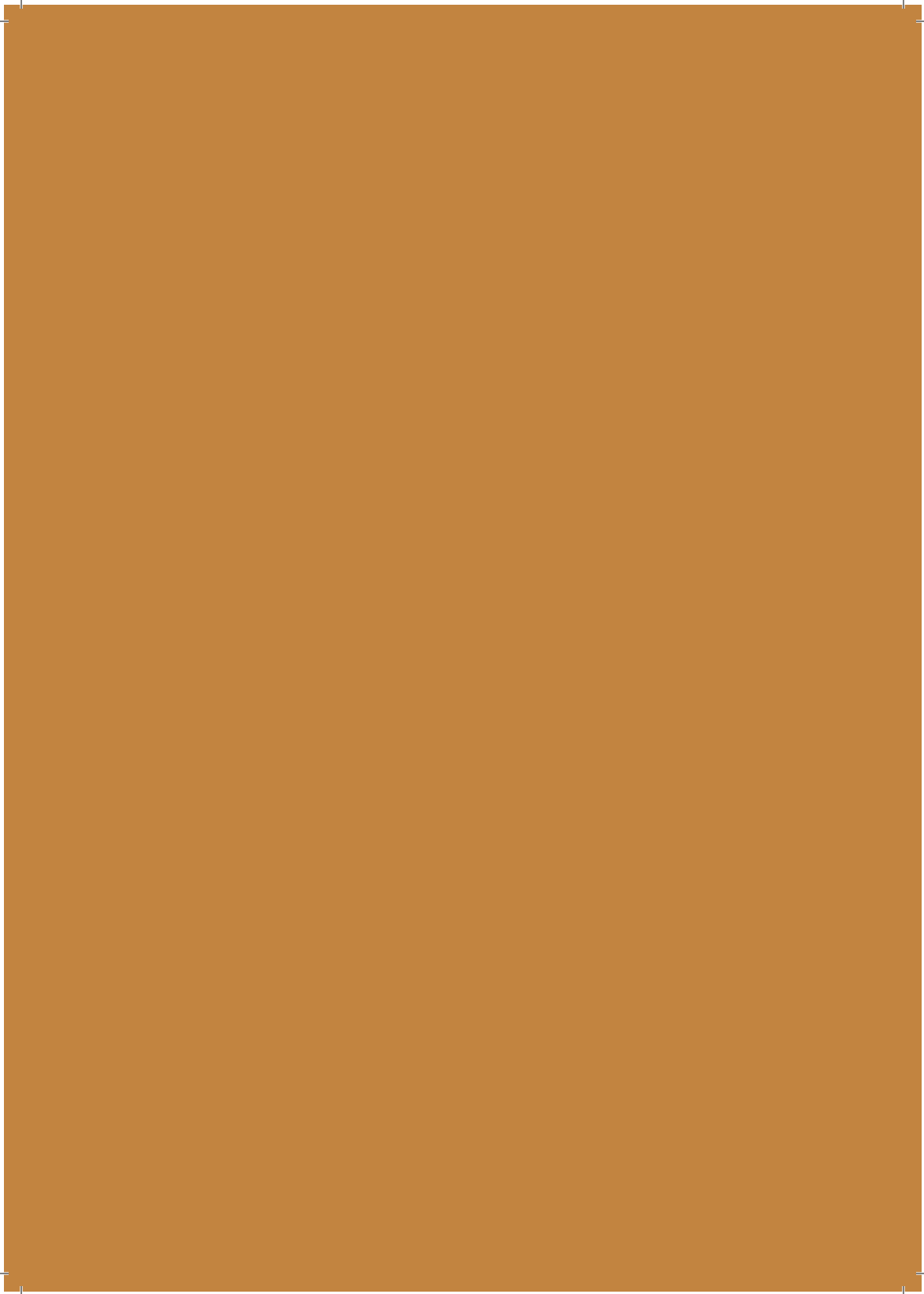

the 1990s, the number of people in the world who are undernourished has increased from 600 million to 800 million (FAO 2001).
