## Laurent-Perrier Brut NV 'La Cuvée'

**Champagne, France** - Fresh and elegant, offering grapefruit, orchard fruits, and honeysuckle, leading to a balanced creamy finish. A light, yet complex mousse texture and fine, persistent bubble.

**Champagne, France** - Complex and expressive, featuring a backbone of orange blossom, white peach, and ripe lemon, balanced by hints of toasted hazelnuts, almond, and beeswax. A rounded and refreshing finish, with exceptional length.

## Prosecco DOC, Riunite 'Movendo'

**Prosecco DOC, Italy** - Pronounced aromas of stone fruit and citrus fruit leap out of the glass, with subtle hints of white blossom and candied lemon. A lively mousse and an refreshing aromatic finish.

**Prosecco DOC, Italy** - Light pink in colour, with a light and fruity palate of red berries, lemon and peach. Undertones of violets and acacia flowers, with a soft and easy drinking fine bubble.

## Crémant de Bourgogne Blanc, Cave de Lugny 'Sainchargny Extatic'

## Blanc Blend, 'Anciens Temps'

**Vin de France, France** - Fresh and expressive showing aromas of citrus fruit, white peach and tropical notes, with a subtle floral character, and refreshing finish. 175ml

## Vinho Verde, 'Lua Nova'

**Vinho Verde, Portugal** - Fresh, zesty and zippy. On the nose expect notes of grapefruit, lemon and melon, with white blossom and acacia flowers, with a slight spritz to finish.

## Chardonnay, Luis Felipe Edwards 'Flor del Fuego'

## Pinot Grigio, 'The Parodist'

**Neszmély, Hungary** - This Pinot Grigio offers a delightfully pure, fragrant expression of this popular grape variety and has abundant peach and grapefruit flavours, accompanied by a ripe citrus fruit notes.

## Albariño, 'Come Pulpo y Bebe'

## Fiano, Tenute Orestiadi 'Molino a Vento'

## Rioja Blanco, 'Conde De Castile'

## Sauvignon Blanc, Marisco 'Fernlands'

## Chenin Blanc, Bruce Jack 'Ghost in the Machine'

**Breedekloof, South Africa** - Produced from 2025 top 100 winemakers of the Year, Bruce Jack. This aromatic and richly textured Chenin boasts ripe stone fruit, with a creamy and nutty undertone.

## Chablis, 'Domaine de Vauroux'

**Burgundy, France** - Classic and delicate, expressing bright white peach, pear crisp green apple fruit, and pure minerality of a wet stone and flint, with a long finish and mouthwatering acidity.

## Sancerre, 'Domaine Reverdy Ducroux'

## **Rouge Blend, 'Anciens Temps'**

**Vin de France, France** - Soft and approachable, with ripe red berry notes of cherry, raspberry and plums with layers of baking spices and touch of fresh herbs. Smooth and easy-drinking.

## **Garnacha, 'Dominio de la Fuente'**

**Castilla, Spain** - A juicy, organic and unoaked red wine, showing great purity of ripe red fruits of plums, redcurrants and cherries with an expressive floral character of violet, typical of Spanish Garnacha.

## **Merlot, Luis Felipe Edwards 'Viña Carrasco'**

## **Pinot Noir, Cramele Recas 'Five Ravens'**

## **Malbec, Catena Zapata 'Tilia'**

**Mendoza, Argentina** - A fresh nose of violets and rich plum marmalade laced with chocolate and vanilla oak flavours. A soft, sweet, fruity wine, leading to a well-structured and long, persistent wine.

## **Primitivo Negroamaro Appassimento, 'Apericena'**

**Puglia, Italy** - A complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

## **Syrah Vioigner, Aubert & Mathieu 'Palooza Rouge'**

**Languedoc-Roussillon, France** - Freshness and intensity of fruit in each glass; a harmonious blend of dark berry fruits of blackberries, cherries and plums, with floral lifts and a touch of spice on the finish.

## **Rioja Reserva, 'Dehesa de Gazania'**

**Rioja, Spain** - Complex and structured. On the nose, aromas of red berries and liquorice combine with layers of oaky aromas of cedar, tobacco and vanilla. Medium-bodied, with a long and structured finish.

## **Cabernet Franc, Bruce Jack 'Ghost in the Machine'**

**Western Cape, South Africa** - Produced from 2025 top 100 winemakers of the Year, Bruce Jack. A burst of dark fruits of blackberry and blackcurrant are met with savoury, smokey, and herbaceous hints. Perfected paired with Beef.

## **Cabernet Sauvignon, Josh Cellars 'Reserve'**

**California, USA** - Scents of bright blueberry, blackberry and plums, backed by powerful aromatic secondary notes of earth, vanilla and spice, with a velvety smooth finish.

## **Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Château Église d'Armens**

**Bordeaux, France** - Structured, yet elegant. Offering an abundance of blackcurrant, plum and red cherry with subtle notes of cedar, tobacco and granite. Fine tannins and balanced acidity typical of Grand Cru Saint-Émilion.

## **Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG, 'Antica Vigna'**

### White Zinfandel, Vinicola Botter 'Hangloose'

**Puglia, Italy** - Bursting with ripe summer berry fruits of raspberry, cherry and watermelon, balanced with fresh acidity and a dash of sweetness on the finish.

### Chiaretto di Bardolino, Pasqua 'Chapter Series'
